On March 13th, 2026, at about 10:08 AM, the Jackson County Sheriff's Office received a report of a suspicious vehicle at a residence in the Town of Irving. The caller requested help with checking on the resident as they were unable to contact them over the phone.

Shortly after, The Sheriff's Office received a 911 call from the residence which reported an unidentified person was located inside the home. The person was later identified as Brian Jaderston, age 48, of Galesville. The Sheriff's Office had Deputies responding already to the scene and the Wisconsin State Patrol were requested to assist as well.

Upon arriving on scene, Deputies found Jaderston was being subdued by bystanders. He became unresponsive and CPR was immediately started. Emergency Medical Services were dispatched and responded to the scene. Lifesaving efforts were made but Jaderston was pronounced dead at the scene.

Based on the initial investigation, it was determined that Jaderston was not known to the resident and did not have permission to be inside the house or on the property. A vehicle associated with Jaderston was located on the property parked behind a garage. It was believed that he had entered the residence with the intent of burglarizing.

This case is under investigation. There is no threat to the public at this time.
