



EAU CLAIRE COUNTY SEEKS APPLICANTS TO FILL COUNTY BOARD VACANCY IN DISTRICT 18

For Immediate Release: April 22, 2026

(Eau Claire, Wis.) - Eau Claire County is currently seeking applicants to fill a vacancy on the County Board of Supervisors representing Supervisory District 18. This district includes portions of the City of Eau Claire, Wards 20 and 57.

County Board Supervisors serve two year terms, with the next election being in April of 2028.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for appointment and to run for election, applicants must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Resides in Supervisory District 18 at appointment and for the duration of the term
- Not have been convicted of a felony (unless pardoned by the Governor or President)
- Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor involving a breach of public trust (as determined under Wisconsin law)
- Not be a current County officer or employee

Individuals may serve as a County Board Supervisor while also holding a position on a town board, city council, or village board of trustees.

Application and Appointment Process

The County's Committee on Administration will accept applications through **Thursday, May 7, 2026**.

Eligible applicants will be invited to interview with the Committee on Administration during its regular meeting on **Tuesday, May 12, 2026, beginning at 2:30 p.m.**

Following the interview process, a final appointment is expected to be made by the County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on **Tuesday, May 19, 2026**. The selected individual will assume responsibilities immediately upon confirmation.
