Outdoor Rinks Closed and Cross-Country Ski Trail Update

Eau Claire Parks, Recreation & Forestry is announcing an update to the Outdoor Rink Schedule as we approach warmer temperatures in the coming days, and the flooding crew works to re-build the ice after last week's warm wet weather.

Boyd, Roosevelt, and Putnam warming shelters will be closed today, Monday, January 12 through Thursday, January 15, 2026. Weather permitting the rinks will be open Friday, January 16, 2026.

Pinehurst warming shelter will remain open for gear share and sledding/downhill skiing/snowboarding.

Due to these warmer temperatures, we ask that you please not use the outdoor rinks while the temperature is above freezing, if there is visible water standing on the rink, and while the flooding crew works to rebuild the outdoor rinks. This will preserve the work that has been done already and will allow the rinks to recover quickly after this warm weather.

Cross Country Ski Trails are hard packed and ice covered. The trails will not be groomed until the next snowfall.
