activation of a fire alarm. Upon making entrance to	the building, crews observed smoke throughout the occupied building and
	ponse. UWEC maintenance personnel shut down the power to Schneider Hall,
	EC PD rescued two people from stuck elevators, one in Schneider Hall and one squickly located and extinguished the fire in an electrical transformer room

Personnel from ECFD, UWEC PD, and the Eau Claire Police Department assisted in evacuating the structure. ECFD crews searched all floors of the building and ventilated multiple floors. Fire crews remained on-scene to ventilate and monitor the air inside
