How Police Became Involved

911 call reporting domestic batter

Narrative of Call

Deputeis responded to a report of a domestic battery at 234 McMillan Ct, Cortland. Deputies made contact with the victim who advised that her boyfriend had bit her arm and hit her leg with a belt. Deputeis observed a bite mark on the victim's arm and a bump on the victim's leg. Deputuies then made contact with the Stephon River who would not cooperate or identify himself and attempted to reenter the apartment where the victim was. Stephon was detained in handcuffs and Deputies attempted to question Stephon but he would not cooperate. Stephon was placed under arrest for Domestic Battery and while at the DeKalb County Jail when Deputies were still attempting to identify Stephon, he provided a false date of birth.
