



# Total Funding for 5-year Plan




The board authorized the creation of the 5-year FMP based on a total budget.

### Process: Phase 1 – Phase 2 – Phase 3




**Phase 1: Deeper Understanding**



### **Guiding Principle 3: Creative Collaboration**


Our schools will create an environment where students and staff can express themselves freely, collaborate and communicate creatively.
