NARRATIVE

On 11/01/2018 at 0855 hours, I was dispatched to 5211 Maryland Way in reference to a theft where I met with the complainant, Molly Chatterjee. She informed me that she contacted Chief Hughes about the theft, and he requested that she come to the Brentwood Police Department to file a report. Mrs. Chatterjee stated that her former tenants stole medical documents and a wine cooler from her residence.

Mrs. Chatterjee currently resides at The Heritage. She owns 6209 Belle Rive Drive. For the past six years, she has utilized Benchmark Realty to rent the property. In May of 2017, specific date unknown, new tenants rented and moved into the residence. The tenants, Donald and Kristen Borgeson, agreed to rent the residence for one year. There were minor ongoing issues with the residence and the tenants. Mr. Borgeson located several things that needed to be fixed in the home, including a large leak. Mr. and Mrs. Borgeson would also not allow the property managers or Mrs. Chatterjee to come onto the property. The property manager needed access to the residence to show the home to future tenants; however, the Borgesons claimed it was an invasion of their privacy.

Mr. and Mrs. Borgeson vacated the property on 05/31/2018. All of their property was removed from the residence by 06/01/2018. After the residence was emptied, Mrs. Chatterjee began repairs on the home for future tenants. Workers have been at residence repairing all of the issues.

On 10/29/2018, Mrs. Chatterjee received an e-mail from Jasmine Roper, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The e-mail stated that a complainant was filed against Mrs. Chatterjee for abandoning medical records in a rental home. Mrs. Chatterjee contacted Ms. Roper via phone to discuss the incident. Ms. Roper informed her that she was contacted by the Borgeson's attorney, Julie-Karel Elkin. Ms. Elkin filed a formal complainant alleging that Mrs. Chatterjee abandoned the medical records in the residence, and her clients had possession of the records.

Mrs. Chatterjee informed me that was a retired physician. She was required to keep all medical records for 10 years before properly disposing of them. Mrs. Chatterjee retired in March of 2011. She maintained all of the needed medical records, exact number unknown, at her residence, 6209 Belle Rive Drive. She placed all of the records in a suitcase in a storage room behind her garage. Mrs. Chatterjee placed a lock on the door to secure the room; however she had to remove the lock for tenants. The storage room contained the fuse box, and tenants needed access to it while residing in the home.

She let other tenants use the storage room for their things if needed and did not secure her belongings in that room. Mrs. Chatterjee believes that the Borgesons stole her suitcase when they vacated the property. She went to the residence to inventory her belongings. She realized a wine cooler was also taken.

Mrs. Chatterjee contacted the Borgeson's lawyer. The lawyer informed her that the medical documents would be returned if Mrs. Chatterjee paid the storage fees for where the documents were stored. Mrs. Chatterjee called Ms. Roper of DHS to inform her of the situation. Ms. Roper stated that the complainant would be closed upon the records being returned, and she was not required to pay the storage fees. Mrs. Chatterjee informed the lawyer of her conversation with DHS, and the lawyer agreed to meet her with the documentation at 6209 Belle Rive Drive.

At this time, the documents have not been returned to Mrs. Chatterjee. She stated that she would contact me if the documents were returned. She requested a civil standby for their meeting. I informed her to contact the Brentwood Police Department prior to the meeting to have an officer available. At the time of this report, no contact was made with Mr. or Mrs. Borgeson. Documentation from Mrs. Chatterjee was attached to this report. No further information was available.

SUPPLEMENT NARRATIVE

On 11/14/2018, I spoke with the complainant via phone. At that time, she had not received the medical documents from the Borgeson's attorney. Ms. Chatterjee informed me that the attorney was unable to contact her clients. She requested that I speak with the DHS employee to obtain further information about the claim.

I spoke with DHS employee Jasmine Roper via phone. Mrs. Roper informed me that she was in contact with both parties. The attorney and her clients have agreed to return Mrs. Chatterjee's property. Mrs. Roper stated that the claim will be closed upon the return of all medical documents.

On 11/18/2018, I spoke with the Brogeson's attorney, Julie-Karel Elkin. Mrs. Elkin informed me that all medical documents will be returned. At this time, she is waiting for the unit number and key to gain access to the documents. She will contact Ms. Chatterjee to return all medical documentation upon gaining access to the storage unit. Mrs. Elkin advised that she had no knowledge of the wine cooler and was only handling the legal claim.

At this time, no further information was available.
