



City of Vincennes Commingle Recycling Program

Acceptable Materials

Aluminum & Steel Cans

All steel, bimetal and aluminum cans are acceptable.

Rinse and remove all lids.

Plastics #1 thru #7 containers only

Acceptable items include milk and water jugs, soda bottles. Labels do NOT need to be removed from soda bottles, soap bottles, etc.

(NOT ACCEPTABLE: motor oil bottles, anti-freeze bottles)

Magazine/Catalogs

Must be kept dry.

Plastic Bags

Black plastic trash bags. Grocery bags #2 HDPE i.e. Kroger, Wal-Mart & Kmart store bags.

Glass – All Types

Brown-Clear-Green

Mixed Paper and Newspaper

Mixed paper consists of any type of clean paper.

Craft paper bags. Papers must be kept dry.

Corrugated Boxes and Paperboard

Remove any Styrofoam or liners from boxes. (NOT ACCEPTABLE: waxed boxes, milk/juice, cartons, juice boxes)

Office Paper

Office paper is paper typically generated by offices, including; white paper, colored paper, and computer paper.

Junk Mail


Junk mail is paper typically received in the mail, including envelopes, cards, flyers and other papers

- ✓ No sorting; just place recyclables loose in the cart
- ✓ Do not bag recyclables
- ✓ Please have your carts out by 6:00 am
- ✓ Recycling service is provided **every other week** (EOW)
- ✓ Pick up location will be determined upon site evaluation





Recycling Guidelines



YES

- Shrink wrap/plastic film/ plastic grocery bags
- All Paper grades/if you can Rip it, Recycle it!
- Clean aluminum foil
- Tin and steel cans/please rinse, put lids in cans
- Glass food jars/please rinse/labels ok
- All plastic bottles marked 1 through 7 /empty



NO

- Styrofoam
- Ceramics
- Light Bulbs/Window Glass
- Magnetic strips
- Mirrors
- Food-soiled items/Pizza boxes
- Plastic flower pots
- Clear dome covers from take out food trays
- Microwaveable food trays
- Wax paper/wax cardboard/wax milk cartons
- Paper towels/napkins
- Electronics

Please do not put into bags - just loose material!
