OR NEARLY three decades, bargain hunters have flocked to Charleston for the annual East End Yard Sale. This year's event, the 28th annual, is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. on May 12 (as it does every year, the event falls on the day before Mother's Day).

More than 100 vendors, from the East End and elsewhere, have signed up to sell at the event. That doesn't include the more than 30 businesses and restaurants that will be open during the event. Street musicians will be set up throughout the event, courtesy of the yard sale's sponsor this year, Old Colony Realtors.

Rain is in the forecast for Saturday, but the event will go on no matter the weather. Adam Stollings, director of marketing and promotions for Charleston Main Streets, said this is his fourth yard sale. It rained during his first, but as soon as it cleared up, people immediately crowded the East End streets.
