Public transportation is a major issue in our community. Currently, less than 15% of bus stops provide shelter from the elements. The Federal Transit Administration will cover 80% of the cost if the remaining 20% is covered. Leadership Tuscaloosa would like to increase the number of shelters through raising money to purchase as many shelters as possible.

Goal: Leadership Tuscaloosa will raise tax-deductible donations from individuals, organizations, and businesses to purchase as many covered bus stop shelters for community residents utilizing Tuscaloosa Transit.
