The charge that Yakima County Clerk, Janelle Riddle, committed misfeasance, malfeasance and/or violated her oath of office alleges she:

- (1) failed to properly and timely transmit to DSHS, Division of Child Support, orders of child support entered in Yakima County Superior Court, resulting in loss of revenue;
- (2) failed to properly discharge her duties to timely transmit to law enforcement agencies restraining orders entered in Yakima County Superior Court;
- (3) refused and/or failed to perform in-court duties required by law, and threatened to shut down or close the Yakima County Superior Court and Yakima County Clerk's Office;
- (4) delayed or failed to comply with the Clerk's duty to create a record and/or index of each judgment entered in the Yakima County Superior Court;
- (5) failed to properly maintain account of the moneys received by the Yakima County Clerk's Office; and
- 6) failed to provide necessary data to create timely billing to Yakima County
 District Court and three municipalities for jurors provided to such entities, resulting
 in billing delays and/or failure to bill issues.

Should Janelle Riddle be recalled from office based on these charges?
