STATE'S MOTION AND ORDER TO VACATE CONVICTIONS AND DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE

MOTION FOR VACATION AND DISMISSAL

COMES NOW Joseph A. Brusic, the elected Prosecutor for Yakima County, Washington, and respectfully moves the Court for vacation of defendant's convictions for First Degree Murder and Second Degree Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and for dismissal of those charges with prejudice for the following reasons:

Witness testimony during the RAP 16.12 reference hearing held Monday, August 14, through Wednesday, August 16, 2023, most likely will result in the Court of Appeals, Division Three, granting the defendant a new trial. Testimony and evidence elicited during the reference hearing demonstrate that the State's case has weakened considerably, beyond what would normally be expected with the passage of over 25 years since the case was originally prosecuted. The



credibility issues revealed during the reference hearing indicate that the State can no longer prove the matter beyond a reasonable doubt and is therefore duty-bound to act accordingly.
