Mentoring and Supporting International Students

During the 2019-2020 academic year in the United States, 19,720,000 or 5.5% of university students were international students (i.e., students not holding U.S. citizenship). In this talk, we will review the landscape of international student enrollment in institutions of higher education. Specific to the United States, we will explore the different ways that current policies and laws define who international students are, including undocumented and DACA students. And for most of our time together, we will engage with narratives describing the experiences of former international students in various university contexts that emphasize the importance of broad and dynamic mentoring and support networks.
