8 must be in writing and must be served upon the undersigned attorney for the Plaintiff at the address  
9 below stated. Within 14 days after you serve the demand, the Plaintiff must file this lawsuit with  
10 the court, or the service on you or this summons and complaint will be void.

12 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so promptly so  
13 that your written response, if any, may be served on time.


