

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of DeSoto County, Florida, on May 12, 2026, or soon thereafter, at the County Commissioners Meeting Room, **Room 103, Administration Building, 201 E. Oak Street, Arcadia, Florida** will consider adopting an ordinance, the title and substance of said proposed ordinance being:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XIX OF THE DESOTO COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES TITLED “THREE PERCENT TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX” OF CHAPTER 10 “TAXATION, ASSESSMENT AND FEES”, by INCLUDING AND CODIFYING THE AMENDED EXHIBIT A INTO SECTION 10-380, titled “County Tourist Development Plan funded” FOR THE PROPOSED USES OF REVENUES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.
