AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF VENICE ORDINANCE NO. 2025-32, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, WHICH ADOPTED THE OFFICIAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; BY INCREASING THE TOTAL REVENUE BY \$4,916,229 AND TOTAL EXPENDITURES BY \$4,916,229; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE
