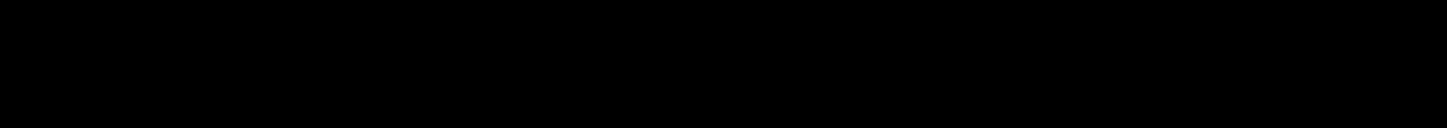

NARRATIVE

On September 20, 2023, I responded to 1 ██████ Scarlett Ave, regarding two missing juveniles.

The caller, ██████ advised her daughter, ██████ and son, ██████ left in her white 2022 Honda Accord (██████). ██████ said she noticed both children missing at approximately 11:25 pm when she checked their bedrooms, and they were not in there. ██████ said she went outside and observed her vehicle gone. ██████ said her keys to the vehicle were inside her purse, which was in the vehicle and ██████ knew where to find the keys. ██████ said she caught ██████ talking to someone on FaceTime earlier in the nights and took the iPad from her because she was in trouble and was not allowed to have her phone or the iPad.

[REDACTED] advised she attempted to call [REDACTED] phone ([REDACTED]), but it was shut off and not receiving phone calls. [REDACTED] stated the kids are from Fort Myers and does not know anywhere where the kids would go to in North Port. [REDACTED] said her vehicle does not have OnStar but has Honda Link, but it was not set up yet. [REDACTED] attempted to set it up but was unsuccessful due to needing to pair the device with the car. [REDACTED] further advised the children removed all their clothes from the bedroom.

[REDACTED] Units with NPPD saturated the area and began checking numerous locations for the vehicle and two children to no avail.

[REDACTED] completed two MEPIC forms, one for [REDACTED] and one for [REDACTED] to have them entered as missing. A dental record form was completed for each of the children as well. [REDACTED] completed a written statement and wished to report her vehicle as stolen. The vehicle was entered into FCIC/NCIC as stolen. The children were entered into FCIC/NCIC as missing. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised there were [REDACTED] at the residence to [REDACTED]. A BOLO for the car and children were disseminated throughout the agency.

[REDACTED] contacted me at approximately 01:34 AM. [REDACTED] advised she received a cash app notification that her card was used at Circle K in Tampa, Florida. [REDACTED] advised an attempt for a withdrawal of \$100 dollars was attempted and declined. [REDACTED] further advised a successful transaction of \$20 dollars was completed. [REDACTED] advised all of her credit cards were in her vehicle when the kids took it. The Cash App card was used at store [REDACTED] Circle K, which is located at [REDACTED].

I made contact with Circle K store clerk, Jenzayi Dorsey, who advised she did see two subjects within the hour matching the description I gave her. Jenzayi advised she did not see the subjects purchase anything in the store but cannot say anything about them purchasing at the gas pumps. Jenzayi said she was new to the store and [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] contacted me again and advised she located text messages on her iPad, where [REDACTED] was communicating with an individual named [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] she and her brother [REDACTED] were on their way to California in a couple of hours. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] she was not going for her, and they would be staying with a subject named [REDACTED]. The texts were
