NARRATIVE

On January 31, 2026, Officer Coss, met with [REDACTED] to follow up with multiple female students from Woodland Middle School regarding allegations involving teacher Bryan Clum. The female students reported that Clum engaged in inappropriate behavior, including unwanted physical contact, standing in close proximity, and staring in a manner that made them feel uncomfortable and unsafe. Both students indicated that this behavior was primarily directed toward female students and did not occur in the presence of school security personnel.

On February 4, 2026, I, Detective Robles, was assigned the case after coordination with [REDACTED] and four forensic interviews were scheduled. On February 5, 2026, I responded to Woodland Middle School, where Principal Terry advised that Mr. Clum had been reassigned to Sarasota County School Board Headquarters with no student contact pending an HR investigation. I documented a classroom similar to Mr. Clum's and took photographs. Principal Terry noted most involved students were [REDACTED] Human Resources investigator Robert Boney confirmed Mr. Clum's temporary reassignment pending investigation.

On February 10, 2026, [REDACTED] conducted separate forensic interviews with [REDACTED] (who will be herein be referred to as Victim 1), and [REDACTED]. Each interview was scheduled at a different time to prevent contact between the students.

NARRATIVE CONTINUED

During the investigation, several additional students were discovered to have inappropriate contact with Mr. Clum. Additional forensic interviews were conducted.

On April 29, 2026, Detective Dewar and I responded to Woodland Middle School to interview students from Mr. Clum's class regarding concerning classroom behavior. Detective Dewar assisted with interviewing male students regarding this investigation. Several students stated Mr. Clum treated female students better than male students and wore "Meta glasses." None reported witnessing him take photographs; however, several stated they heard he used the glasses to photograph female students and was no longer employed for "touching girls."

I interviewed female students to many of which stated that he excessively touches them on the arms, shoulders and back. The students also stated they felt that he stared at their buttocks and would record them on his Meta glasses. One student believed he had an erection in class because she saw a bulge in his pants when he stood up. A total of 52 students were briefly interviewed.

NARRATIVE CONTINUED

Bryan Clum has a history of inappropriate behavior from several years. In 2013, while employed as a math teacher with the Pasco County School Board, Bryan Clum was reportedly subject to disciplinary action after materials described as sexually explicit comic books were found in his classroom in an area accessible to students. According to the report, when questioned by Human Resources, he stated that he believed the materials could serve as reading options for students despite his role as a math instructor.

In 2018, a 14-year-old female student at Woodland Middle School reported to her parents that she felt uncomfortable and afraid of remaining after school with her teacher, Mr. Clum. A forensic interview was conducted with the juvenile female student and she alleged that [REDACTED]

In 2025, several students came forward regarding Mr. Clum being inappropriate in class. Some of the female students saw him at the Aquatics Center in North Port and they stated once they returned to school, he made odd comments. The students disclosed similar inappropriate behavior by Mr. Clum, including unwanted touching. These incidents had not previously been reported to the North Port Police Department. I contacted two of the students' parents regarding forensic interviews. Both parents agreed to bring them to [REDACTED] for an interview.

On May 7, 2026, [REDACTED] conducted a forensic interview with [REDACTED] (who will herein be referred to as Victim 3). Victim 3 stated that [REDACTED]

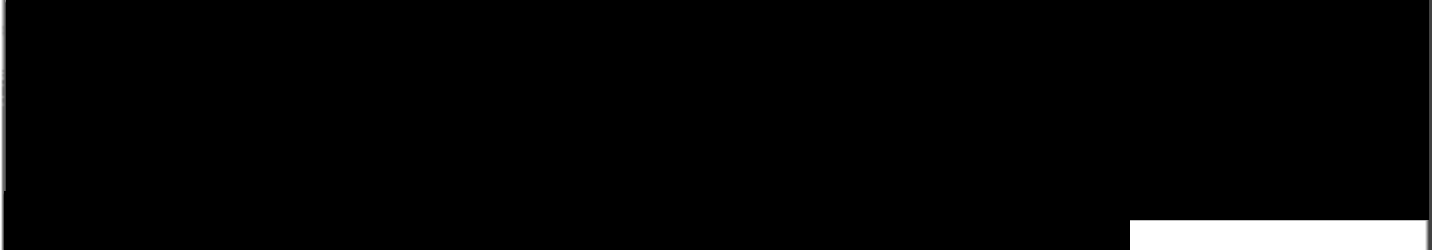
