Project Recap

- ➤ AE & CM Contracts were approved by the Board on August 2, 2022
- Project Kickoff meeting was held on August 24, 2022
- ➤ Schematic Design is complete including drawings, project narratives, Educational Specifications, and DOE OEF Form 208
- ➤ Stakeholders toured the Collier County prototype (Aubrey Rogers High School) currently under construction on December 2, 2022
- > Design Development has started

Project Highlights

- ➤ This is the first NEW high school in Sarasota County since North Port High was built in 1993
- ➤ The Project Team has been coordinating with the developer, Mattamy Homes to create an educational focus within Wellen Park, and working around wetlands, coordinating trails and ponds, and securing the safest site access
- The school will have approximately 2,100 student stations
- The school will be a single building, three-story, secure campus of approximately 325,000 s.f.
- Programmatic emphasis is on Career and Technical Education, Science, Agriculture, Arts, and Athletics

Budget

- > The current budget is \$175,000,000
- > The CM is working on the Schematic Design estimate
- Cost of construction, lead times, transportation, product availability and labor shortages continue to challenge our team.
- ➤ We will be presenting budget validations for Design Development and Construction Documents.

This is the first NEW high school in Sarasota County since North Port High was built in 1993. The other high schools have been renovated and/or partially replaced.

Sarasota County School Board closed on the purchase of this 130.4 acre parcel on May 18, 2021. In conjunction with future residential growth and development of east-west roadways to the north of the site, the Project Team sited the building facing northwest and is strategically avoiding impacts to the wetlands on site.



First Floor Plan

Utilizing a High School prototype from Collier County as the foundation, the Project Team worked with Sarasota County Schools stakeholders (including Security, IT, Food & Nutrition Services, Instructional, Student Services and many others) in order to customize and improve the plan to make it "Sarasota's Prototype."



Second Floor Plan

Sarasota County Schools has not built a new high school in decades, so this project was a great time to think about secondary education, changing technologies and new pedagogies. As a District, it has made us rethink facility design and how that impacts teaching and learning.



Third Floor Plan

The new high school will have mini administration suites in each classroom wing to locate student services where the students spend most of their time.

Instructional clusters such as Science, CTE, and Engineering will group similar classrooms and labs to afford maximum ability for staff and students to collaborate and interact.



Districting for the New School

Growth in South County has prompted the need for a new high school to relieve over-capacity and address future capacity needs at Venice High School.

Developments that have submitted for School Capacity and School Concurrency Determinations are projected to add an additional 2,563 total students into these schools in the next 1-10 years.
